An evocative soundscape in the old Brackenbury infant school building created by young people from 'Portland Rocks' and artists Ivon Oates and David Rogers.

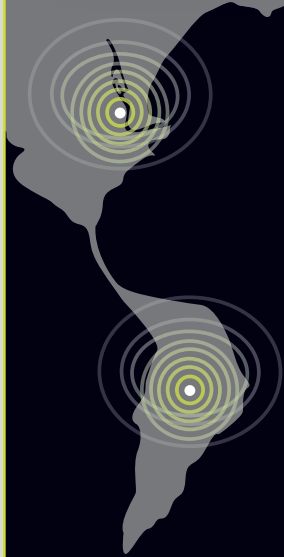
